RAILWAY MUSEUM has a Mallard, Replica Rocket and Queen Victoria's 'Palace on Wheels'; and currently on display is the famous Eurostar!

Climb to the top of **CLIFFORD'S TOWER** for a view over the city and take a walk along part of the **CITY WALLS**.

YORK MINSTER the largest medieval cathedral in the north of Europe. Tour one of the most beautiful gothic cathedrals that has been central to York's history for 2000 years.

CASTLE MUSEUM has recreated 400 years of York's history; a Victorian street, toy shop, debtors prison and much more.

FLAMINGOLAND has white knuckle rides, amusements and is home to over 1000 animals in its zoo.

EDEN CAMP was a World War II prisoner of war camp and is now a museum to visit which will bring the history to life.
